Parking Equipment Reconfiguration


Project: Relocation of entry parking equipment to better serve customers entering 2nd Street entrance due to 2nd Street traffic reconfiguration from one-way to two-way.

Logistics: Currently, 2nd Street Garage's entry /exit on 2nd Street is configured for one-way traffic. The entry/exit is opposite of a normal two-way traffic pattern. We are proposing to relocate the entry /exit lanes to better serve the two-way flow from 2nd Street. This involves reversing the existing lanes and moving the equipment approximately 20-30 feet towards 2nd Street. This project also includes an increase in signage and striping to help customers navigate the garage.

Costs:	Equipment Relocation – Evens Time	\$47,905.50
	Sign changes- FastSigns	\$10,094.60
	Striping- Morgan's Striping	\$ 500.00

Summary: The Columbus Redevelopment Commission will partner with Cummins to make the changes necessary in the 2nd Street Garage. Cummins will pay for the improvements to the garage and REI will coordinate the project work.


