

Created in 1988 and renamed in honor of Chuck Wilt, long-time Director of the Columbus Parks and Recreation Department, the Chuck Wilt Youth Scholarship Program awarded over \$14,000.00 in scholarships in 2012. Swim Diapers:

All persons who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper. We wish to avoid fecal accidents which can cause the pool(s) to close several hours or several days. Infant/Toddlers swim diapers may be purchased from the pool cashier.

Masters Swim/Deep Water Walking (Outdoor)

Deep Water Walking for adults will be offered in the diving well from 12-1pm daily (no evening hours). This is a self directed program and participants must provide their own floatation devices.

Note: Except for Parent/Child Aquatics, Level 1 & Adult Lessons, students must be able to demonstrate all the completion requirements of the previous level or have a certificate from the previous level. All students will be evaluated the first day of class.

Parent/Child Aquatics:

Ages 6 wks.- 3 yrs.

The objective is to help children become comfortable in and around water. A parent/trusted adult must accompany infants/toddlers.

Pre-School: Ages 3-5 yrs.

This is a swimming readiness class.

Students will explore water environment through games and play.

Levels 1-5

Minimum age is 6 yrs.

Level 1: Intro to Water Skills

This class will help children feel comfortable in water and enjoy the water safely.

Level 2: Fundamental Aquatic Skills

Students will attain success with fundamental skills.

Level 3: Stroke Readiness

This class will build on the skills in Level 2 through providing additional guided practice.

Level 4: Stroke Improvement

Students will develop confidence in the strokes learned and improve other aquatic skills.

Level 5: Stroke Refinement

This class will provide further coordination & refinement of strokes.

Level 6: Swimming & Skill Proficiency

Strokes are refined so students can swim with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances.







Group Ice Skating Class Descriptions
