

Rocky Ford Road Improvement Project
Informational Meeting

Construction on Rocky Ford Road from Taylor to Talley will begin soon.

The proposed improvements include the addition of curb and gutter, a storm sewer system, a continuous left turn lane, and sidewalks. Bicycle lanes will be added in both directions along Rocky Ford Road the entire length of the project.

You are invited to attend an informational meeting from 6:00 pm to 7:30 pm on Thursday, March 10 at the **Richards School cafeteria, located at 3311 Fairlawn Drive**. The purpose of this meeting is to let residents know what to expect during tree removal, utility relocation and construction. Information on the construction schedule and detour routes will also be available

This will be an informal open house. You may stop by to look at the plans and talk with representatives of the City and the design engineers and the contractors.
