Second Reading of an Ordinance entitled "ORDINANCE NO. 16, 2024, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF COLUMBUS, INDIANA, REZONING THE SUBJECT PROPERTY FROM P (PUBLIC & SEMI-PUBLIC FACILITIES) TO RM (RESIDENTIAL: MULTI-FAMILY)." (Housing **Partnerships** Rezoning) Jeff Bergman presented this ordinance. He stated Housing Partnerships proposes to rezone the former Columbus Health & Rehabilitation facility site at 2100 Midway to RM (Residential: Multi-Family). The property consists of 15 acres and is currently zoned P (Public & Semi-Public Facilities). Jeff displayed maps and photographs of the area. He stated the Columbus Plan Commission forwarded the application to City Council with a favorable recommendation by a vote of ten (10) in favor and zero (0) opposed. Brief discussion followed. Vice President Anderson opened the meeting for public comments. Patchett, 4721 Clairmont Drive asked what ensures this project is affordable housing. Kevin Johnson with Housing Partnerships stated most of their housing projects range in the 30, 50 and 60% AMI (area median income). Vice President Anderson closed the meeting to the public. Second Reading of an Ordinance entitled "ORDINANCE NO. 17, 2024, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF COLUMBUS, INDIANA, REZONING THE SUBJECT PROPERTY FROM I2c (INDUSTRIAL: GENERAL WITH COMMITMENTS) TO RM (RESIDENTIAL: MULTI-FAMILY)." (Vision Housing - Omega Drive Rezoning) Jeff Bergman presented this ordinance in addition to the following ordinance at the same time. He explained Vision Housing is requesting rezoning for two adjacent properties on the west side of Indianapolis Road at Omega Drive. Jeff stated the applicants are proposing the rezoning for the purpose of developing the property for multi-family residential. He displayed maps and photographs of the area.

Jeff stated the Columbus Plan Commission forwarded both applications to City Council with a favorable recommendation by a vote of ten (10) in favor and zero (0) opposed. Discussion followed. Vice President Anderson opened the meeting for public comments. Kerri Sinibaldi asked if access to the Omega property would remain as Indianapolis Road. Jeff indicated the connections of Indianapolis Road and County Road 150 W are perceived as fairly critical. Zach Patchett asked if the city bus would ever service this area. Second Reading of an Ordinance entitled "ORDINANCE NO. 19, 2024, ORDINANCE **AMENDING** THE **COLUMBUS** BARTHOLOMEW COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AND OFFICIAL ZONING MAP FOR THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS." (Columbus Front Door Overlay Zoning District) Jeff Bergman, Planning Director, and Jessie Boshell, Senior Planner, both presented this ordinance. Jeff explained the request is to adopt the creation of the Columbus Front Door Overlay Zoning District, and amend the Official Zoning Map rezoning the Columbus Crossing PUD from PUD to CR (Commercial: Regional Center). Jessie stated the intent of the Columbus Front Door Overlay Zoning District is to incorporate basic architectural standards that would encourage thoughtful design that enhances the front door into the City of Columbus. These standards were designed off of what is existing in the area and the standards would apply to new construction, redevelopment, and expansions. Jessie displayed photographs of guideline examples. Much discussion followed. There were no comments from the public. Councilor Hilber made a motion to pass the second reading and adopt the ordinance. Councilor Kestler seconded the motion. G. Second Reading of an Ordinance entitled, "ORDINANCE NO. 20, 2024, **ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR** THE **ADDITIONAL** APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR THE BUDGET YEAR 2024." Jeff Bergman presented this ordinance. He stated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is most federally funded, with the MPO budget being 80% federal and 18% city and 2% county. Jeff stated there is a surplus of funds to be captured and is seeking an additional appropriation of \$80,000. He indicated the Engineering Department is requesting \$30,000 of these federal funds for audits of five of the City's top crash intersections, \$20,000 for Flood Risk Management Plan and Food Response and Evacuation Plan, and \$30,000 to purchase new stationary and mobile bicycle & pedestrian counters to be used on the People Trails. Brief discussion followed. Vice President Anderson opened the meeting for public comments. Zach Patchett asked the location of the five most dangerous locations. Andrew Beckort, City Engineer, stated the locations are Central and 25th St., Central and Rocky Ford, Central and 10th St., Marr and 25th St., and Marr and Gladstone.
